Project Profile - Howard County Hospital



Lacy Construction Company constructed a 10,000-square-foot clinic addition for Howard County Hospital in St. Paul, Nebraska. The structural steel building with masonry exterior adds 18 exam rooms, six offices, a triage area, staff lounge, procedure rooms and multi-purpose rooms. Another phase of the project was to build a new main entry with a drive up drop off area to the hospital, this new entry also serves as the connection between new and existing facilities.

Design of the clinic layout includes two separate hallways, one for the patients, and the other for staff. The staff corridor includes several workstations for nursing staff and physician's to take notes, record data, and research patient history. Finishes include: oak trim work, custom patterned carpeting, tiled bathrooms, and painted walls.

In order to expedite the work, the project was performed in phases. Once design was complete on the foundation, construction of that phase began while the other areas were still in the design phase, which in turn have been constructed as design was finalized.
