

Project Profile - Medical Specialists Clinic



This new 11,000 Sq Ft building was built by St. Francis Medical Center to have clinics available for new doctors relocating to the area. Initially only 5200 Sq Ft was finished during the construction. The balance was left unfinished ready for the new candidate to equip as they wish.

The completed portion includes six exam rooms a procedure room and a lab. The interior finishes include wall coverings, carpet, quarry tile and solid surface laminates. Wood casing and trims were used extensively in the clinic. Those included wood base, chair rail and crown molding. Custom cabinetry was used at various workstations as well as the reception counter. The unfinished portion of the building was completely unfinished allowing flexibility to meet the needs of virtually any kind of specialist who chooses to locate there.

The exterior of the building utilizes red brick, giving it the “Colonial” look to coordinate with the surrounding buildings in the development area. The masonry includes stone keystones, column caps and windowsills. Other exterior features include custom columns, crown fascia and pre-finished fascia with raised dentils.
